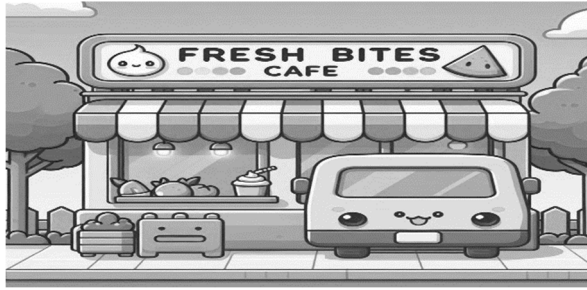

Have you ever seen a video in which someone ~~seems~~ to say or do something surprising? What ~~told~~ you that video might not be real? This could be a "deepfake."

A deepfake is a type of video or image made using ~~computer~~ technology* called artificial intelligence (AI). The AI can take pictures and videos of a person and create ~~something~~ that looks real but isn't. For example, a ~~fake~~ might show an actor saying words they never actually said or make it look ~~like~~ someone is dancing when they weren't.

Deepfakes can be fun and creative. However, they ~~also~~ can be dangerous. Some people use deepfakes ~~to~~ fake news, trick others, or harm someone's ~~reputation~~. This is ~~why~~ important to think carefully before believing ~~everything~~ you see online or on TV.

Luckily, experts* are working on tools to find ~~deepfakes~~. You can also stay safe by checking if videos ~~come~~ from trusted sources and asking yourself, "Does this look too strange ~~to~~ be real?" Deepfakes show how powerful technology ~~can~~ be, both in good and bad ways. What do you think? Should we be worried ~~about~~ this technology?

Green noise is a type of sound that is soft and ~~calm~~, often *compared to natural sounds like ~~ocean~~ waves, waterfalls, or *rustling leaves. It sits between white noise and ~~low~~ noise. White noise has all sound *frequencies ~~equally~~ mixed, like a "hiss" while brown noise is deeper, like thunder. Green ~~noise~~, however, focuses on middle-range* sounds, ~~making~~ feel soft and comfortable.

People often use green noise to help them relax ~~and~~ for sleep better. For example, if you have ~~trouble~~ sleeping, listening to green noise might help you feel calm and fall ~~as~~ faster. It can also other noises around you, making it easier to focus when studying or reading. Many people enjoy green ~~noise~~ because it *reminds them of nature. Hearing ~~noises~~ that feel like being outside can help make less *stress and make you ~~more~~ peaceful.

Scientists are still studying what green noise ~~has~~ to do with the brain activities, but many ~~people~~ already find it helpful in their daily lives. Whether you use it to study, ~~relax~~, or sleep, green noise is a simple way to ~~feel~~ comfortable and focused. It's like bringing a little bit of nature into your ~~every~~ day life.
