(五) Every day, restaurants, supermarkets, and families throw away much food. According to environmental experts, one-third of the food produced in the world is wasted each year. This problem not only wastes money but also harms the environment because making food need water, energy and transportation.

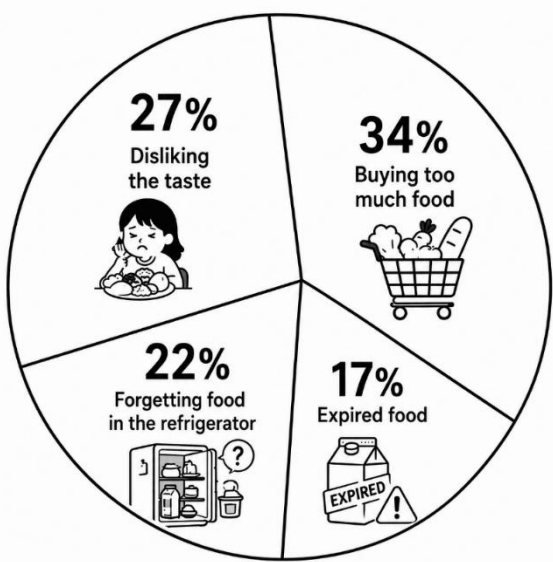
To understand why teenagers waste food, a research group in Asia studied the main reasons and got the results as the chart below.

The researchers found many students bought snacks or drinks simply because they were on sale, even when they didn't really need them. Besides, busy life often caused families to forget food stored in fridges until it expired.

Food waste also leads to climate change. When wasted food is thrown into landfills, it produces methane gas, which is harmful to the environment. Some scientists believe reducing food waste may be one of the easiest ways to lower pollution and save natural resources.

To solve this problem, schools in several countries have started educational programs about responsible consumption. Students are encouraged to plan meals carefully, check expiration dates regularly, and share extra food with others when possible.

Experts say although one person's actions may be small, millions of people making better choices could create an important impact on earth
